

Activity: Determining Market Share

1.	Examine the market size.
	Take time to examine what data is available in the <i>NHS Profile</i> , <i>2011</i> by following this link http://www12.statcan.gc.ca/nhs-enm/2011/dp-pd/prof/index.cfm?Lang=E . Search either by "Place Name" or "Postal Code." Click your relevant area in the search results. This will take you to a page with the NHS Profile for your area. Next from the "Select a View" menu, explore "Income of Families," "Income of Households," and "Income of Individuals."
	For example, an examination of the households in Kamloops in 2010 shows that 26,200 (75%) have after-tax income in excess of \$50,000.
